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Benefits of Reading

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Did you know that reading out loud to your child is one of the most important things you can do to help prepare your child for Kindergarten? Here are just a few of the benefits that your child receives when you ★ read together-

- New vocabulary is introduced.
- ☆ 。 Your child can "visit" or learn about places (both real and fantasy) that he/she has not visited in person.
- ☆ Reading strengthens the bond between the parent and child.
 - Your child's attention span and ability to focus improves through hearing stories.
 - By seeing an adult read, your child starts to get the connection that printed words have meaning.

☆ • Children who are read to regularly tend to form a love of books! Take a little time each day to read to your child.
